From the Pastor's Desk

My dear parish family:

The Holy Spirit, who is central to the Solemnity of Pentecost, which liturgically concludes the Easter season, is sometimes referred to as the “neglected person of the Trinity.” However, our Lord expressed the importance of the Holy Spirit. He left the Paraclete, the Holy Spirit, who is a comforter, advocate, and helper with us to guide us in all things. Pope Benedict XVI said, “The Holy Spirit is almost the interpreter who makes God and us ourselves understand what we want to say.” St. Paul of the Cross said, “You could not love Jesus if you did not possess the living source of holy and pure love, namely, the Holy Spirit.” Here is the Litany of the Holy Spirit for us to pray especially when you need God’s help with discernment. May this moment of commune with the Divine reinvigorate us to do God’s work – every day! The Litany of the Holy Spirit is powerful. Pray it often, not just on Pentecost.
